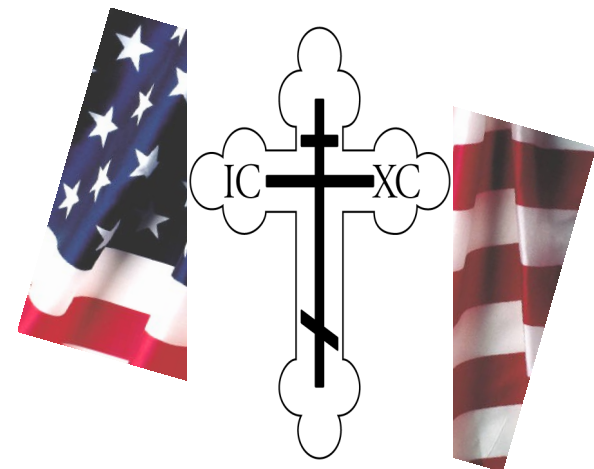




**THANK YOU,
