# Holy Week Ideas

<u>Holy Week Resurrection Eggs</u>-we did this with Tykes a couple of years ago, please find attached document called <u>Resurrection Egg</u> for the list of things needed

# Holy Week Crafts Cross -we did this last year with Tykes (Picture attached to email)

a. attached you will find a word document named Journey to Pascha Wall Cross Labels - you can print them as labels or print them out on regular paper, cut them out and glue them on
b. If you don't have a wooden craft cross you can always put these on regular paper or foam paper

# Holy Week Train

a. Take a magnetic wooden train and for each day of Holy Week, add a new train car to the train b. Print out the **Journey to Pascha Wall Cross Labels 3** doc, cut the icons out and tape them to each new train car

# 1. Saturday of Lazarus (John 11:1-45 Lazarus)

a. Transfiguration is going to send out a virtual skit for all to see

b. Make the Lazarus Cookies

# Young Child Skit

a. If you have a pop-up tent, pull it out to use for St. Lazarus' tomb. If you don't have a pop-up tent then make a fort. Wrap your child up in a sheet and have him go into the tomb. Then say to your child, Lazarus come out and have your child come out of the pop-up tent or from another room. Afterwards, have them unwrap themselves.

-If you don't have a sheet to use and you are able to spare some toilet paper, wrap your child in that to be St. Lazarus

# 2. <u>Palm Sunday (Mark 11:1-11 The Entry to Jerusalem)</u>

a. Go out and find a leaf/palm

-Put holy water on them while Father says the special prayers at the end of the service

- walk around the house saying, "Hosana in the Highest"

-Place the palms at Icons

# Young Child Skit

a. If you have stuffed animals, use them for a puppet show

-you'll need pretend stuffed animal townspeople waving palms, a pretend donkey and Jesus

-have Jesus ride the donkey while the townspeople are saying, "Hosana in the Highest"

# 3. Palm Sunday Night (Matthew 21:18-43)

a. Frame a picture of the Bridegroom Icon and decorate it

-Process with Father and put the icon in a special place in the home

-Venerate the Bridegroom icon service while happening online

b. place a kandyli (lit) candle with olive oil in front of it if you have one

# <u>Craft</u>

a. If you have some small wood pieces your child could paint the wood and then you can glue the Bridegroom Icon onto the wood

b. DIY oil lamp-keep your jelly jars and/or any type of mason jars

# Young Children Craft

a. use a battery-operated light to put in front of the icon

-put the battery-operated light into a cut up throw away water bottle and have the children decorate the outside of it

#### Young Child Skit

a. if you have any type of animal that the children can sit on, turn it into a donkey
 -hold palms and say, "Hosana in the highest" while your child is on the pretend donkey

#### 4. Holy Monday & Holy Tuesday (Matt. 21:18-20)

a. read the story about the Wise and foolish Virgins (Matt. 21:18-20)

<u>Skit</u>

a. act the story out with each other

# Young Child Skit

a. use your stuffed animals again to act the story out with someone being the wise virgin and another person being the foolish virgin

#### 5. Holy Wednesday -Holy Unction and Judas agreed to betray Jesus

#### (John 13: 3-8)

a. put flour in a bowl or sand depending on what is available

-put 7 candles in it and a kandyli in the middle if you have one

-while watching the service light each of those candles as you hear the reader and Father recite the seven epistle and gospels

-if you have young children, you can always use 7 battery operated candles

b. use a cotton ball with holy oil to anoint each other

#### Skit-Judas agreed to betray Jesus Matthew 26:15

a. have someone be the chief priest and someone be Judas and read the passage acting it out -grab some change and count out 30 coins

# 6. Holy Thursday -Holy Thursday Morning/Holy Thursday Evening

(Matthew 26:2-20, John 13:3-17, Matthew 26:21-39, Luke 22:43-45, and Matthew 26:40-27:2) a. use the flour from the bowl and make Prosphoro and eat it after Liturgy like Andidoro b. After eating your supper with the kids, wash your children's feet

# <u>Craft</u>

a. Have the children carry the cross around the house just like Jesus had to carry his cross to Golgotha

b. Print out an icon of Jesus and frame it

-Decorate it and venerate it

# c. make a cross out of sticks, two pool noodles (see attached picture) or whatever you may have

-take your Icon of Jesus that you printed out and put on the cross

d. using playdough or clay make a hill with three crosses on it

-ask the children, why three crosses?

-what did someone say to Jesus while on the cross?

e. take a cup of water and something red (Sauce, red food coloring) to show the children how water and blood poured from Jesus' side when he was pierced with a sword

f. Dye your Eggs Red

# Young Child Craft

a. make a crown of thorns

-take a paper plate and cut the middle out of it and paint it. Then pick up sticks in the yard to put around the plate to resemble thorns

-put this crown over the icon you put of Jesus on the cross

#### Skit-Peter denies Jesus 3 times

a. a skit with the kids-one person be a solider and the other be Peter

-have the solider ask Peter if he knows Jesus 3 times

-have Peter dene the solider 3 times

-have someone make a crow sound and Peter realize what he said

# 7. Holy Friday

(I Corinthians 1:18-2:2, Matthew 27:1-38, Luke 23:39-43, Matthew 27:39-54, John 19:31-37, and Matthew 27:55-61, Ezekiel 37:1-14, I Corinthians 5:6-8, Galatians 3:13-14, Matthew 27:62-66)

have the children take the icon of Jesus on the cross down and wrap it in a white cloth
 If no icon of Jesus, take the cross and wrap it in a white cloth

b. find some cloves in the house and have the children small the cloves-Jesus' body is being prepared for burial

c. have the children put Jesus' body/cross inside of the tomb

d. process with Jesus' tomb outside in the evening and carry candles or battery-operated candles

-go under your tomb like you would in the one at church to re-enter the church -or just kneel and then venerate the icon at home

# <u>Craft</u>

a. Make a tomb out of a box (Empty Cereal box/Amazon Box) and decorate it with flowers or paint inside and outside

- 8. Holy Saturday Morning (Romans 6:3-11 and Matthew 28:1-20)
  - a. Watch the live streaming service with Jesus' body still in the tomb
  - b. walk around the house with bay leaves or any leaves singing, "Arise O God, and judge Thou the earth..."
  - c. After the Divine liturgy and sometime before Holy Saturday Evening, take Jesus' icon out of the tomb to show that he is no longer there
  - d. if you have any scented oils, have the children smell them and pull out some spices for them to smell

# Young Child Craft

a. if you have clay or playdough laying around, have the kids make a tomb and a stone

-when they roll the stone out of the way, the tomb will be empty

# Skit- Myrrh Bearing Women

- a. Create a tomb out of your pop-up tent or make a fort to be a tomb
- b. Have the children carry oils and spices to bring to the tomb
- c. Have someone be an angel to tell them, "Jesus is not here, He is Risen"

# 9. Holy Saturday Evening (Mark 16:1-8)

- a. Darken the house
- b. Have one child have the lit candle or battery-operated candle on and then have them pass it to everyone else.
- c. Have the kids sing "Christ is Risen"

-give the kids candles to process around the house or battery-operated candles

# 10. <u>Agape Service (John 20:19-25)</u>

- a. Read the gospel in different languages
- b. teach the kids to say Christ is Risen in many different languages
- c. Have the kids crack their red eggs
