FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

2021 Q1

Q: What, exactly is the New Mount Tabor (Parish Community Center) project?

A: In order to keep pace with the growth of our parish and our ministry programs, we are planning to expand by building a New Mount Tabor hall, 14720 square feet. The project includes new classrooms, administrative offices, banquet/fellowship hall facilities with a stage and commercial kitchen, space for ministry meeting rooms and offices, a proper bookstore and increased parking capacity.

Q: How will the New Mount Tabor and increased parking capacity be used?

A: To address our Parish needs; this is our best solution for Parishioners now and in the future.

- **To create more and larger Sunday School classrooms.** Our New Mount Tabor will have 14 classrooms and meeting rooms for over 250 students. Our 2019 year-end Sunday School program enrollment is 160 an increase of 40% from 2012. Our current Sunday School facilities are inadequate.
- **A better Banquet hall with elevated stage.** Our new banquet hall in the New Mount Tabor is 4,200 sq. ft. and can accommodate 280-320 people. Using this hall, we can host events such as the Gala or a Wedding reception. Our current hall is 2,600 sq. ft. with a capacity of 175 people and is mismatched with the capacity of our Sanctuary at 300.
- **Better kitchen and administrative facilities.** The new 620 sq. ft. Parish kitchen will meet required commercial kitchen standards and requirements. Our current kitchen is 245 sq. ft. and is inadequate to meet Parish needs.
- **Adequate offices and workrooms for our ministries.** Our Church and New Mount Tabor are wonderful ways to continue to bring our members together in our youth ministries, Greek School, Philoptochos, Religious education, Retreats, Community nights.
- **To minimize disruption of current classroom and ministry activities,** we will use current Mt. Tabor Hall and the Base parking spots during construction of New Mount Tabor
- **New sources of income for our Church.** The new community center Hall and Kitchen creates a wonderful atmosphere for weddings, large and small meetings, gatherings, celebrations, parochial schools, and organizations.
- **Parking relief:** We have 87 marked spaces and will continue overflow parking at the military base. We will lose 20 parking spaces lowering the New Mount Tabor building to the ground and then gain 55 surface parking spaces by replacing the current Mt. Tabor Hall with a Parish parking lot. A future project is a Parking Structure and Recreation Center on the Mount Tabor Hall property.

Q: Where can we see the latest project information and designs?

A: Our Parish website will be maintained throughout the project <https://transfiguration.org/>. Updates are provided at Parish Assembly meetings. Detailed drawings are will be available as the project progresses.

Q: What is the project budget?

A: We expect to spend 6.5M million on the project.

Q: Where will those New Mount Tabor funds come from?

A: The financing for the will come from two sources:

- **Down Payment \$4.5M:** Fundraising \$3.5M plus \$1.0M funds set aside from operating budget mortgage accrual, gala, golf, luncheons, and Greek Festival.
- **Mortgage Loan \$2.0M:** 20-year loan, expected interest rate of 5.5%.
- Mortgage financing can be reduced if the Parish strongly supports our special events: including TGOCC Greek Festival, Parish luncheons, Gala sponsorship and silent auction and the Golf tournament.

Q: Is it easy for me and my family to contribute to this project?

A: Yes. We have set up a Pledge Sponsor program. Pledging provides an opportunity to give a more significant amount to the campaign because the pledge is structured to allow for a longer period to fulfill your pledge commitment. Pledge Sponsor contributions can be made through EGiving or check payments, made payable to Transfiguration Greek Orthodox Church expansion project in the memo line.

Q: Can you show how easy it is to make a multi-year pledge, paid over four years?

Q: Should everyone in the Parish participate?

A: Yes. Every member of our Parish, including new Parish members are integral to our success!

Q: Can I make a gift of stocks, bonds, or life insurance?

A: Yes, please discuss with your financial advisor, and reach out to the Church office for assistance.

Q: How much should my family and I contribute?

A: Christ Himself tells us, *“From everyone who has been given much, much will be demanded; and from the one who has been entrusted with much, much more will be asked.”* (Luke 12:48). It is the same here. Please participate at a level relative to your financial means.

Q: Can I increase or change my pledge?

A: Absolutely! This is a pledge. It is not a legal binding obligation.

Q: Will we require a mortgage loan for the New Mount Tabor? How much will the loan be?

A: Yes. \$2.0M - 20-year mortgage loan, with an estimated rate of 5.5%

Q: What preparations are we making to secure and service our loan?

A: We are committed to a conservative approach to project financing. We are setting aside gradually increasing sums from the church operating fund until the amounts equal the anticipated monthly mortgage payment. The funds that are set aside are placed in a restricted account to help with the project down payment. This effort is completely independent from project fundraising and will be funded from recurring sources of revenue thereby demonstrating that the church can service the long-term loan obligation.

Based on Transfiguration’s current and forecasted revenue, quantity of families, value of the building, as this is an amount that will help our Parish achieve our needs without jeopardizing our financial future. This conclusion was developed in partnership with our bank utilizing standard credit-loan evaluation methods.

TGOC has been preparing to support \$2.0M loan. The total cash on hand for the project is up to \$2.3M as of February. For 2020 and 2021 budget our goal was to set aside \$10K/month for future mortgage payment. This is planned to increase to \$12K per month next year. When combined with the funds from our annual gala, golf tournament, and luncheons, we will be well positioned to address the \$14K monthly payment that will be needed to service the \$2M loan.

Q: What financial preparations are necessary to secure a mortgage loan from a Bank?

A: The largest two factors in securing the loan will be our ability to make the planned \$4.1M down payment on the project and the demonstrate to the bank we are capable of assuming the loan. A successful fundraising program will address the one-time outlay associated with the down payment and continuing growth in stewardship will ensure that our revenue is at the levels needed to secure the loan. Our assessment is based meetings with ABC Bank on the commercial loan factors that the Bank uses that demonstrate we are capable of assuming a loan: Balance Sheet, Debt Coverage Ratio, Loan-to-Value, Debt to Income, and Cash Reserves.

Q: Has Transfiguration Parish had prior fundraising projects? Were they successful?

A: Yes. Our Parish has a history of strong fiscal management and maturity.

- 1998: Mt Tabor Hall \$146K raised, \$139K mortgage paid off.
- 2002-2006: New sanctuary and Icons: \$2.1M (\$400K loan) 150 families raised \$1.3M.
- 2011: \$78K raised instantaneously for pews
- 2011-2012: Phase 2 Icons, lighting, sound, rugs: \$336K, 170 families raised \$370K.
- 2013: Sanctuary loan is paid off.
- 2016: Consecration and Walkway 140 families raised \$515K
- Feb 2021 New Mount Tabor Project, we have \$2.3M set aside from Fundraising and Pledge received, mortgage accrual, Luncheons, Festival, Golf and Gala.

Q: Does Transfiguration Church have a mortgage now?

A: No. In fact, during 2019 we set aside \$8.5K per month in preparation for a future mortgage on the New Mount Tabor hall. For 2020 and 2021 budget our goal was to set aside \$10K/month for future mortgage payment. This is planned to increase to \$12K per month next year. When combined with the funds from our annual gala, golf tournament, and luncheons, we will be well positioned to address the \$14K monthly payment that will be needed to service the \$2M loan. We are showing ourselves that we are ready to take on mortgage servicing obligations.

Q: When is New Community Center construction expected to begin?

A: 2022

Q: When is the center expected to be completed?

A: 1 to 1.5 years after ground is broken.

Q: Is our Church an extension of our own home?

A: Yes, it's a dwelling place for the family; offers peace and security; a place you will always feel loved; a familiar setting where you feel comfortable and safe; where you can be yourself and feel like you belong.
