







1985: Mission Parish w/Fr. Nicholas Triantafilou

- In August 1985, Reverend Nicholas C. Triantafilou, Proistamenos of Annunciation Cathedral in Houston, visited Austin to meet Greek Orthodox families interested in establishing the first Greek Orthodox Church in the growing state capital area.
- December 1985: His Grace, Bishop Anthimos of Denver visited Austin and gave his blessing to proceed with the new parish – with this the Greek Orthodox Church of Austin was born.
- 1988: At the recommendation of Father Nick, the membership voted to officially name the church The Transfiguration Greek Orthodox Church (celebrating its feast day on August 6).










Divine Liturgy in Mt. Tabor Hall






