





St. Paul's Letter to the Galatians 2:16-20

Prokeimenon. Mode Plagal 2 Psalm 27.9,1

O Lord, save your people and bless your inheritance.

Verse: To you, O Lord, I have cried, O my God.

The reading is from St. Paul's Letter to the **Galatians 2:16-20**

rethren, knowing that a man is not justiied by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ, even we have believed in ἐπιστεύσαμεν, ἵνα δικαιωθῶμεν ἐκ πίστεως Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Χριστοῦ, καὶ οὐκ ἐξ ἔργων νόμου · διότι οὐ Christ, and not by works of the law, because by works of the law shall no one be justified. But if, in our endeavor to be justified in Christ, we ourselves were found to be sinners, is Christ then an agent of sin? Certainly not! I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me; and the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

The class will teach reading, writing, pronunciation, modern Greek grammar, conversational Greek, and we will also cover Greek culture elements. Topics of your personal interest, like songs, psalms, prayers, recipes etc. will also be included. No textbooks are required, at this time. We will talk about books in class.


