Dear faithful of the Metropolis of Denver:

On September 1, our Holy Christian Orthodox Church celebrates the beginning of the New Ecclesiastical Year. The Church also calls us during this month to approach with reverence the Holy Cross which we commemorate on September 14th. This is a great day as witnessed to by the faithful who venerate the Holy Cross to receive its divine grace.

The Elevation of the Holy Cross is a time to renew our efforts towards spiritual development for ourselves and our children. It is imperative that we all "take up" our cross to traverse the road of Christian Orthodoxy and to live with goodness, righteousness, and truth, protected by the power of the Holy and Life-Giving Cross.

There is no other emblem more honorable and holy for the Christian heart than the Holy Cross. The Cross of our Lord is the means of our salvation. On the Cross the Redeemer spread out His hands and by His sacrifice, returned the sinful man to the Grace of God. It is for this reason that our forefathers established the Holy Cross Greek Orthodox Theological School in 1937. Since the first graduating class of 1942, our clergy and lay graduates have been called to "...take up [the] cross..." to follow Christ. For eighty-three years, the graduates of our seminary have faithfully and prayerfully, guided the dedicated stewards of our parish churches to build loving communities united in Christ Jesus.

Supporting the sacred mission of Hellenic College and Holy Cross enables us to focus and to have a strong awareness of our Christian conscience, our history, our sacred Tradition, and our Church. It is for this reason that I call upon you to support and participate in the education of our young people that have been called to serve Christ and His Church.

I ask you once again, to make a special collection in our parishes on Sunday, September 14th, the Elevation of the Holy Cross. As the Holy and Life-Giving Cross of our Lord is raised once again this year, I ask that you please send your offering directly to the Metropolis of Denver by September 29, 2025. Kindly make your contribution payable to the "Metropolis of Denver, Attention HCHC Fund." As a means to represent your loving support and encouragement for our young people at HCHC, all proceeds will benefit the students from our Metropolis that are studying specifically for the Holy Priesthood.

In recent years, we have seen an increase in the number of young men responding to our Lord's call to serve as priests. This year is a banner year for our Metropolis! We have eight students in the Master of Divinity enrolled in our Theological School. It is the largest number that we have had in years. In that same vein, there are three students in Hellenic College that are in preparation to enter Holy Cross in the coming years. In addition, the last three years have enabled us to award scholarships amounting to approximately \$200,000! The funds collected benefit our students who will be our future priests. It is the goal is for them to graduate, through your generosity, debt free.

In anticipation of your loving support, may we all bend the knees of our body and soul as we acknowledge the grace that we receive from the Holy Cross. In this way, we will be become worthy in our veneration of the Holy Cross.






