
TGOC History Overview


- 1985: Mission Parish w/Rev Nicholas Triantafilou
- 1986: Began using Parish Hall of St. George's Episcopal Church
- 1988: Official name The Transfiguration Greek Orthodox Church
- 1990: Purchased our current 4.2 acres
- 1991: Ladies Philoptochos Society established
- 1993: Divine Liturgy at Mt. Tabor Hall facilities.
- 1997: Fr. Jordan G. Brown became our Priest
- 2004: Our Byzantine Church Sanctuary opens
- 2006: First phase of Sanctuary Iconography
- 2009: Fr. Michael Lambakis became our Priest
- 2010: Fr. Vasileios Flegas becomes our Priest
- 2011: Beautiful wood pews installed
- 2012: Iconography Dome Project completed
- 2013: Our Parish mortgage is paid off
- 2016: Parish Walkway and TGOC Consecration
- 2018: Launch TGOC Parish Expansion Project

- 2024: Mount Tabor Community Center opens




1985: Mission Parish w/Father Nicholas Triantafilou

- August 1985: Reverend Nicholas C. Triantafilou, Proistamenos of Annunciation Cathedral in Houston, visited Austin to meet Greek Orthodox families interested in founding the first Greek Orthodox Church in the growing state capital..
- December 1985: His Grace, Bishop Anthimos of Denver visited Austin and gave his blessing to proceed with the new Parish – with this the Greek Orthodox Church of Austin was born.
- 1988: At the recommendation of Father Nick, the membership voted to officially name the *Church The Transfiguration Greek Orthodox Church* (celebrating its feast day on August 6).



The first phase of Sanctuary iconography, including the Platytera, the Dormition of the Theotokos, the Hierarchs, and the major feasts in the life of Christ were installed in the Sanctuary in September 2006.
